#### b. Senior Administrative Officer Report May 7, 2024

Procurement bylaw 269/19 Recommend rewrite with independent legal advice and allow the SAO to proceed with negotiated contract for the construction season. Meanwhile ensure that all procurement decisions are backed with council Authority (motions) if the procurement/project is already voted within the 5-year capital plan. Repeal the bylaw to fit the size of this community.

Deep water lake raw pump house: Council has approved \$1,000,000 in FY 2024/25 of the Capital Plan for the subject project. SAO has an open discussion with Atco Frontec, Yellowknife, and Calgary to deliver a pre-built pumphouse, complete with 2 generators, 2 pumps, and solar to be built at their plant and then transport directly to Deep Water Lake, set up and relocate the old pump house to Fort McPherson for repurposing to be complete by Autumn 2024.

Motion to approve continuation of talks between the Hamlet staff and Atco representatives that will lead to a negotiated contract to construct and deliver the Deep-Water Lake Pumphouse in the summer/autumn of 2024.

Concrete Floor Truck shop on Highway 8

The floor has sunk and needs replacement, as a cement floor, Council has approved \$450,000 in FY 2024/25 of the Capital Plan for the project, The SAO has an open discussion with Ace Enterprises in Yellowknife to prepare the ground, stabilize the shifting of the floor and build a concrete floor, set to the requirements of Hamlets heavy equipment.

Mayor Blake suggested to the SAO get quotes from Whitehorse Dawson and Inuvik as the options are closer and would cost less.
